



COVID STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

.orgCommunity is preparing for The Innovation Summit so that all individuals on-site – attendees, speakers, staff, and venue personnel – remain safe, healthy, and comfortable throughout the event.

.orgCommunity has taken preventative measures to reduce the spread of communicable disease including, but not limited to, COVID-19 at The Innovation Summit event. All event participants are required to abide by all applicable COVID-19-related requirements, advisories, policies, procedures, and protocols of the [OLC Education and Conference Center](#), the [World Health Organization \(WHO\)](#), the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](#), and the state of Illinois, as well as any other governmental authority for the duration of their stay.

Any person disclosing or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, or knowingly exposed to the disease, should stay home and will be refused admittance to the event.
